Go Green e-mail Disclaimers and Desktop Screens

- Increases in-house staff awareness
- Recipients are encouraged not to print unnecessarily
- Staff to adhere to Doha Bank's green policies

Go Green message on ATM print screens

- Receipt print-outs are minimized
- Trees are saved by not printing receipts
- Educates customers to do their banking electronically

Environment-friendly Tips and Checklist

Here are some simple and effective ways to get you started:

Energy Efficiency - to save energy usage and cost

Home/Office Equipment and Appliances

- Shut down or turn on power-save modes on equipment and appliances.
- After shutting down the computer, switch off the monitor as well.
- If you have to use batteries, buy rechargeable batteries and a charger.
- Attach home/office equipment and appliances to power strips for ease in switching off.

Lights

- When exiting rooms, make it a habit to turn off the lights.
- Use energy-efficient LED lights to replace the fluorescent and halogen lights.
- Flickering fluorescent lights to be replaced promptly.
- If possible, increase usage of natural light.

Temperature

- Purchase AC with climate control for less energy usage.
- To prevent excess heat, close the windows and blinds after work.
- Apply weather stripping to all doors and windows.

Water Efficiency - to reduce water consumption and cost

- Leaky toilets and water valves to be fixed promptly.
- Close water taps properly.
- Check for water leaks on periodic basis.
- Purchase water efficient toilet supplies and equipment.
- Water hose in gardens to be set in automatic mode.
- Collect water drops from AC to water the plants.

Plastic Bottles

- Drink from mugs / glasses, rather than plastic bottles.
- Install water dispensers to minimize plastic bottle usage.
- Dispose off plastic bottles properly.

Responsible Paper Usage - to minimize / eliminate paper waste and cost

- Usage of Reusable Inter-Office Mail Envelopes.
- Establish a baseline of white paper usage.
- Edit documents on-screen.
- Apply small fonts up to the standard.
- Adjust the page margins when acceptable.
- Avoid usage of colored papers if possible.
- Update mailing list to avoid sending duplicate mails.
- When writing notes, do it on the fax itself and eliminate the cover sheets.

Printing / Photocopying

- Reduce unnecessary and excess printing / photocopying.
- Re-use papers by utilizing the back portion.
- Purchase post consumer waste recycled paper.
- Refrain from printing draft samples.
- Set the printer to print on both sides.
- Conserve paper by printing and photocopying double-sided.
- Print using the lowest quality print setting.
- Use the reduction feature to fit more on a page.

Office Supplies & Furnitures

- To encourage purchase of green materials.
- Purchase office supplies in bulk with minimal packaging.
- Buy refills instead of buying new pens / printer cartridges.
- Utilize available materials before purchasing new supplies.
- Purchase products from environment-concerned suppliers.
- Use products that are recycled and recyclable.
- Install non-toxic recyclable carpeting.
- Buy environment-friendly biodegradable cleaning supplies.
- Fix or donate broken furniture.
- Purchase multi-functional furniture to save more space.

Air Quality Maintenance - to improve indoor air quality

- Add more plants to your homes/offices.
- Apply natural fertilizers to plants.
- Replace air filters as required.
- Make use of low VOC paints for walls.
- Utilize AC with auto-shutters.
- Ensure proper ventilation.
- Launch a "NO SMOKING" POLICY to protect indoor air quality.
- When possible, use non-chemical methods for pest control.

Waste Management - to reduce, reuse and recycle

- Increase awareness about recycling and proper waste management.
- Initiate an in-house recycling program.
- Proper disposal of hazardous materials.
- Maintain cleanliness and order.

Reduce

- Avoid unnecessary packaging and plastic waste.
- Use durable goods to minimize waste and repairs.
- Say NO to junk mail / unwanted catalogs.
- Start a garden in your backyard to reduce buying processed fruits and vegetables.
- Start a compost with biodegradable household waste.
- Use cloth bags when giving gifts, avoid paper wraps.

Reuse

- Patronize eco-friendly green shopping bags when purchasing.
- Use washable containers instead of disposables.
- Repair items that can be repaired than replace with a new one.
- When thinking of replacing reusable items, donate the old ones to charity.
- Hold a garage sale, give away or swap reusable items.

Recycle

- Recycle used printer cartridges.
- Electronic materials and computers can be recycled by specialist shops.
- Buy products that have recyclable packaging.
- Sell/Donate old magazines, newspapers and other paper products than throw them away.
- Recycle old tires to build new coral reefs.
- Soda Cans can be recycled into other aluminum products.

TRANSPORTATION USAGE

- to reduce carbon emitted to the environment

- Use fuel-efficient vehicles.
- Carpool to work to reduce road traffic.
- If possible, utilize technology to minimize travel.
- Check the vehicles AC for less energy consumption.
- Replace tires to maximize performance and save energy.
- Regularly tune-up vehicles to minimize carbon emission.
- When in traffic, minimize the use of horns to minimize noise pollution.
